





EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of El Paso has commissioned SWA to prepare Design Standards for the Cohen Entertainment District, located at 9700 Gateway N. Boulevard, El Paso, Texas. As a very important precursor to this endeavor, a clear vision needs to be established, one that sets the tone and the direction for future development to be high in guality and cohesive in all elements comprising the built environment: from the architecture, its style and aesthetic, to the lighting types and landscape elements carefully arranged to create beautiful public spaces. In addition, the Cohen Entertainment District is to be a place where the elements of entertainment bring people together to join in an experience, to create memories in a wellexecuted project, one where the selected activities on offer, whether part of private or public initiatives, are inviting and specific, a place that brings the community together; a destination in its own right.

The team involved in this wonderful opportunity to support the city in its ideation of an entertainment center, comprised of three firms: Mycotoo, SWA and HLB Lighting. Mycotoo lead the efforts for the vision, creating the identity for this intent.

SWA and HLB supported Mycotoo in their vision, through their specialty: SWA in landscape architecture and through guiding principles for sustainable placemaking; HLB through contributing in their lighting expertise to help create safe areas, responsive to the intended character and vision. Both SWA and HLB will continue on to prepare the Design Standards which will take the contents of this Vision Book. and with greater refinement and detail, establish a road map to achieve the vision through the standards. Details of the Design Standards will be included in that document. while this document, the Vision Book, will serve as a reference, available as the constant, which holds the vision; the intent and the aspirational qualities of this very special place in El Paso.

Create a dynamic combination of mixed-use elements which have active frontages, visibility and are visually coherent.

Create integrated circulation for walking, bicycling, jogging throughout the property. Develop complete streets, Reduce visibility of vehicular parking: ensure seamless connectivity with the circulation system within property.

A PLACE FOR ALL



Create a pedestrian-friendly promenade, at grade, which links the more active/sports-related areas to the more family-oriented developments.

GREAT ACTIVE FIELDS AND OPEN SPACES



Create grand open spaces which are active and comfortable. Additionally terraced landscape within the development with buildings set within the stepped landscape.

A RESILIENT SYSTEM



Create a cohesive vocabulary that ties landscape to ecology. Embrace surrounding natural landscape / views (towards the mountains and the city) and provide for suitable trees and planting based on site and micro-climate.

A COHEN LEGACY



Harness aspects and elements of the existing Cohen Stadium. Create a presence at edge of the site which is a staple of the property and the City (homage to The Cohen Brothers).

Background

With a name honoring beloved El Paso legends, the Cohen brothers of Major League Baseball fame, Cohen Entertainment District is far from the average sports or retail complex, clearly a child of El Paso's unique climate of heritage, adventure, family, striking landscapes, and burgeoning industry.



Cohen Entertainment District Style

Cohen Entertainment District will be high-energy, immersive, cool, hands-on, and visually distinctive. It delights in surprising visitors with an interweaving of elements ordinarily separated: A bustling market in the middle of a park. A field edging into a state-of-theart sports facility. A hotel room with views of both the valley and the mountains. A retail row nestled in the Texas mountains.

Cohen Entertainment District can be many things to many people. While sports fans and players may come to participate in their favorite games, they will find a plaza that caters to their lifestyle and great, wholesome name brand dining.

Sports are just the start. Families desiring a safe, clean outdoor spot to come together in El Paso will seek out Cohen Entertainment District. Couples with an active lifestyle wanting a new jogging trail will seek out Cohen Entertainment District. Individuals wishing for stunning, comfortable mealtime views of the sun-soaked Franklin Mountains will seek out Cohen Entertainment District. Cohen Entertainment District is an immersive, integrated entertainment district that celebrates socialization, fun, and redefining the use of public space.

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The site is located along the 54 Highway (Patriot Freeway), next to the parallel road: Gateway North Boulevard in the corner with Cohen Avenue. It is east of the Franklin Mountains, close to Highway 375 (East / West), which traverses the city and links to the Upper Valley. Its location, so close to the intersection where these major roads meet, is ideal for accessing from different parts of the city.

With easy access from the North / South 54 Highway, visitors crossing from the border at Ciudad Juarez, or arriving in a nearby airport can easily take the road directly to this wonderful destination. Some 20 minutes away by car, it is not long before one reaches the site from historic Downtown or other city attractions, such as the El Paso

In addition, the site is part of an area, between the 54 and the 54 (bus) Highways, that supports nearby residential and institutional zones. Since the Biggs Army Airfield and Fort Bliss are in the vicinity to the East, the site as it rolls away from the Franklin Mountains, offers expansive views to the natural landscape, less densely developed.

The Castner Range – Fort Bliss Military Reserve on the base of the Franklin Mountains to the West, also offers a beautiful protective landscape to regard.





The site is located in the current Cohen Stadium and surrounded on three sides by major roads. The setting of the site is heavily influenced by the beauty of the Franklin Mountains, which rise right behind it. These mountains will create a backdrop and constant reminder to being in El Paso, the "sun city", while engaging in outdoor recreational and entertainment activities.

Cohen Field is the multipurpose centerpiece of Cohen Entertainment District. It is a large-scale, uncovered field purpose-built for Cohen Entertainment District. The field has several unique features which differentiate it from comparable stadiums.

Guests will not find standard bleachers here. Once again commenting on the neighboring Mountains, seating is terraced and naturalistic.

Beyond reservation slots for community practice, the venue is purposed for entertainment events and concerts, including a large-scale media screen for branded content and music experiences. It is the ideal place for community lawn-based events, such as a Dog Adoption Day, an evening Lantern Festival, or simply watching a movie together under the stars.

Lighting Strategy:

Lighting a multi-functional lawn/activity/gathering space for a variety of purposes will require integration of specialized lighting systems. Iconic pole structures could incorporate clusters of smaller amiable lighting sources for general lighting while secondary arrays or alignments of pedestrian scale lighting can be placed at the perimeter for spectators. Coordinating these with the architectural elements of the adjacent building is a recommendation.

Following arrival wayfinding, the Park gives way to a Plaza that serves as a serene gathering place with greenery, artistic water features, and seating. Standing here, guests may see a tiered view of the sunrise, trees, and sleek buildings. This is one of numerous "postcard moments" which are deeply embedded in Cohen Entertainment District's DNA.

Throughout the day, this Plaza plays host to several pockets of activity that are entertainment-driven. Live music, art festivals, and additional surprises are programmed into the day. Seasonal events and 5K Runs treat this Plaza as a major artery. As night draws in, guests may return to the Plaza for a poignant Tree Lighting Ceremony.

From the Plaza, guests can depart in many directions depending on their mood and plans.

From the moment guests arrive at Cohen Entertainment District, their expectations are playfully upended. Perhaps expecting an un-themed, simple drag to the signature Cohen Field, they will first engage with a whimsical Entry Park of shared grass areas. Cottontail Park includes landscaped alcoves for shaded seating, taking in sights, yoga demonstrations, holistic instructor-led events, and more. Guests are delighted to see things like 10' x 10' shipping containers repurposed as part of a natural scenic panorama, now markers on a jogging course. At dusk, these elements come alive with artful nighttime programming and interactive light installations.

Cottontail Park is not a straight promenade – it causes guests to slow down and appreciate their surroundings. Forms comment on the natural undulations of local arroyo river beds, with walkways and water features. Guests will also find a naturalistic playground and arrival retail and dining options. All elements of Cottontail Park ruminate on the concept of wellness.

Lighting Strategy:

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Vertical illumination is often more useful in creating the perception of brightness in landscaped areas. Pathways benefit from a low level approach so that the landscape accents can provide the beauty and excitement. Balancing the light between foreground and background can enhance the feeling of destination and sense of place.

Another way to express this is by emphasizing an approach of putting light where it is needed, creating a visual backdrop and de-emphasizing the utilitarian.

The large-scale Arroyo Leagues Complex is a must for the City of El Paso, which will manage facilities for an indoor fitness center, volleyball, basketball, and other touring league sports. There is even room for a roller rink in the off season. Arroyo Leagues is sure to be humming with activity 365 days a year, but in addition to offering practice and game space it also advertises a multispecialty gym, with memberships and incentives for local visitors.

Continuing Cohen Entertainment District's dance with nature, the high-end design of this space looks to bring the "outside in" at many junctures. An exterior food and beverage footprint is connected, so that this kiosk can service both outdoor and indoor guests.

Facilities have sun-soaked window space and surprising touches like moss-covered interior walls, organic dark wood benches, lifestyle vending machines, and an expansive roof deck. The Complex's sensibility is enhanced with Texan and Mexican pop art accents and temporary installations from visiting artists.

Meandering away from the Plaza, guests can find three distinct Markets along main pathways. These Markets activate and engage what would ordinarily be simple transitional paths. Varied market stalls act as connective tissue, uniting several walkways in the Cohen Entertainment District plan.

These fully-integrated, immersive marketplaces each have unique layouts and character: the first arcade gives the impression of a quaint local market which, over time, has been roofed and enhanced with a graceful archway. The second is a free flow thoroughfare with pockets of connected themed façades. The third Market offers several stalls with unique identities. Programming for all three Markets within Mercado de Cohen is diverse, a hybrid of Food Hall and Retail Boutique.

Because the Mercado de Cohen Markets are fully outfitted with lighting and sound system infrastructure, they also present seasonal themed lightscapes for evenings and holiday events.

In addition to the presence of the Markets, the pedestrian paths from the Plaza to the rest of Cohen Entertainment District are dotted with picturesque Food and Beverage Kiosks, themed as eclectic Food Halls with a fun, "plug and play" style. Lighting Strategy:

In addition to any proposed lighting pole or standard, retail storefront and signage lighting (or even building-mounted sconces), that would provide the general ambient lighting in the retail and social gathering spaces, a variety of additional layers of light are strongly recommended.

Effective options include overhead point sources or "sparkle" lighting in the form of festoons; judicious use of landscape accents, within trees and at planting material in the ground plane; low level illumination at seating and benches, re-interpretation of "Living Room" lighting to create areas of personal intimacy... even surprising placement of lighting in areas programmed for interaction to name a few.

There are many opportunities for "magical" lighting in this dynamic heart of the development.

Acacia Square is integrated with a distinct look and feel for shared social spaces. It makes a refined statement for guests approaching from the southwest side of the property. Organic, repurposed materials form architecture and seating. Wherever possible, natural elements echo throughout the layout.

By composing this cool, non-traditional environment for dining and retail, Cohen Entertainment District aims to attract influential companies and brands that could flourish in a place like this. From a programming perspective, Acacia Square will thrive when the right developer and like-minded tenants join in its mission to offer families safe, fun leisure in a refreshingly natural context. Gateway North Boulevard

The buffer area creates a strong bold presence through the use of environmental markers which traverse the length of the site. The use of colored vertical piers / markers creates a rhythm giving presence to the site. These markers, clearly visible while driving along the north-south highway, have dynamic lighting, continuously creating a colorful and magical effect.

The buffer area here is also complemented with beautifully arranged desert landscape, carefully arranged in geometric patterns. These landscape features integrate seamlessly with the pedestrian / bike path, weaving a natural and distinctive tapestry.

Cohen Avenue

This buffer area and streetscape is made up of a wide path, ample enough for pedestrians, seating, and effective shade elements (trees and structures) giving this area a leisurely and informal feel; amicable to families and crowds to linger and wait for a ride, have a sandwich or just pass the time between events.

Attention to the lighting experience at the surrounding roadway and intersections and street level can serve to identify this development as being unique. Visitors should immediately sense that they have entered a special place, one where special design is specific to the district. This can be achieved by providing a strategy where the sensitivity to lighting levels, distinct from adjacent neighborhoods (or even the color temperature of the light) "announce" entries, or special vehicular and pedestrian access points. To make this a success, integrating architectural and landscape lighting into a composition that enhances a "brand" is a must.

This can then set a stage that draws the public into a luminous environment of multi-varied experiences.
